- ◆ Complete the assessment within six months of the completion of the workshop

### Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)

Applicants who have gained equivalent levels of competence through previous studies may be eligible to have their competence recognised towards the qualification.

### Articulation

Candidates who seek recognition as a Certified Practising Project Director (CPPD) as a part of the AIPM's RegPM certification program can opt to be assessed for CPPD at the same time as the Advanced Diploma.

Note that a successful Advanced Diploma assessment does not mean acceptance under the AIPM's CPPD standards.

To complete the CPPD process candidates first need to follow the AIPM registration process, become a AIPM member and must meet the requirements set by the AIPM for certification as a CPPD.

### Recommended Entrance Requirements

Diploma of Project Management (strongly recommended) or equivalent and a working knowledge of the PMBoK®, AIPM, AS ISO 10006:2003 or equivalent recognised PM Standards.

Participants must currently be working at a senior level within a project environment. They must have accountability for a work based business initiative involving a range of projects at the Program Manager level.

### Outcomes

Broadened knowledge of Program Management aligned with PMI's Guide to the Project Management Body of Knowledge (PMBok®).

Ability to focus on strategic aspects of program management which are significantly different to project management.

### Opportunities

Graduates of this course will be able to integrate multiple projects, a program of related projects, a mega-project or a multi-faceted organisational change to achieve planned business outcomes, while successfully managing internal and external client expectations.
